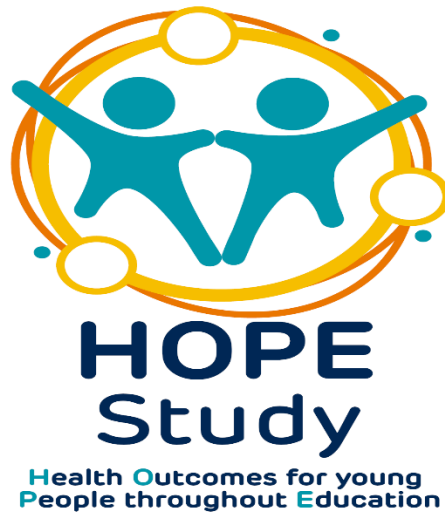


The HOPE Study Launches Three SEND National Surveys



The Health Outcomes for young People throughout Education (HOPE) study launched three surveys on the 1st July 2022.

These surveys aim to explore the variation in Special Education Needs and Disabilities (SEND) identification and provision across all local authorities in England. The three surveys have been designed for children and young people with SEND, their parents and carers, and wider stakeholders (professionals working in education, the health services, and for local authorities).

An integral part in the development of these surveys was the involvement from HOPE's three advisory groups. This allowed each survey to reflect the lived experiences of children and young people with SEND, parents and carers of children with SEND, and professionals working in education, the health services, and for local authorities.

This also allowed the HOPE team to ensure the survey was accessible as possible, whilst including key questions each of the advisory groups wanted to ask across all three surveys.
